August 23, 1942 - December 16, 2013

Age 71, of Morris, IL, formerly of LaGrange, IL, passed away Monday, December 16, 2013 at his home. Born August 23, 1942 in Beecher, IL to the late Robert H. and Florence (nee Koelling) Rohr. He was baptized September 6, 1942.

Veteran of the United States Army, having served in the Korea Conflict and the Vietnam War, where he was awarded the Purple Heart and Bronze Star. Retired from the United States Postal Service. Arthur was an elder at Shepherd of Peace Lutheran Church in Braidwood, IL. He loved nature and was a volunteer for the Goose Lake Prairie Partners. He had many hobbies, but his favorite was woodworking.
