Anne L. Sullivan, 97 of Braidwood, IL, was gently called from her home to eternal life on Tuesday, November 12, 2013. She was born in Braidwood on March 16, 1916, the daughter of Daniel J. and Margaret I. (nee Casey) Sullivan.

A graduate of Reed-Custer High School, Anne retired as an Executive Secretary at Illinois Bell Telephone Company, in downtown Chicago, after a long career.
