Brian Andrew DuBois

Age 55, of Appleton, Wisconsin, formerly of Braidwood, IL, passed away Monday, February 13, 2023 in Wisconsin. Born on April 18, 1967 in Joliet, IL to Richard and Ann DuBois. As a young boy Brian loved all sports, but baseball was his passion. He was very competitive and always felt the need to win. Brian graduated in 1985 from Reed-Custer High School. That same year he was drafted to the Baltimore Orioles, then went on to play with the Detroit Tigers. After his years of playing in the MLB he continued work with AT&T and also enjoyed his time coaching. He is survived by his mother, Ann DuBois of Wilmington; his sons, Tyler of NJ, Bryan (Kayla) of Springfield, IL, and Zach (Nikki) of Springfield; grand-daughter, Emmy Maye of Springfield; siblings, Dennis (Kelly Larkin) DuBois of Essex, IL, Christine (the late Jeff) Crompt of Braidwood, Laura (Randy Davis) DuBois of Gardner, IL; niece, Kaylee Crompt; nephew, Ryan Garbin; and girlfriend, Elizabeth Lehrer of WI. 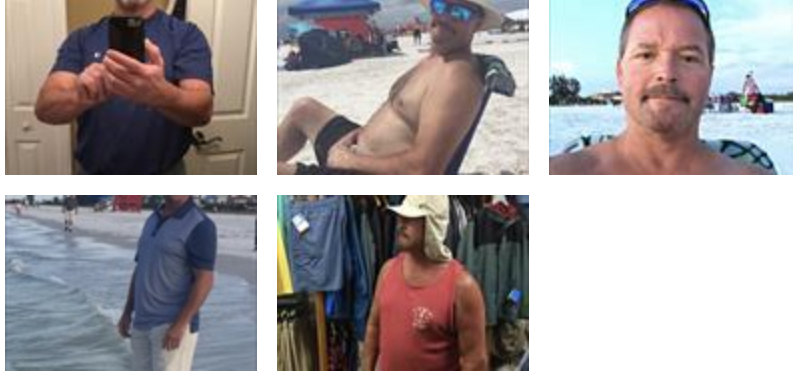

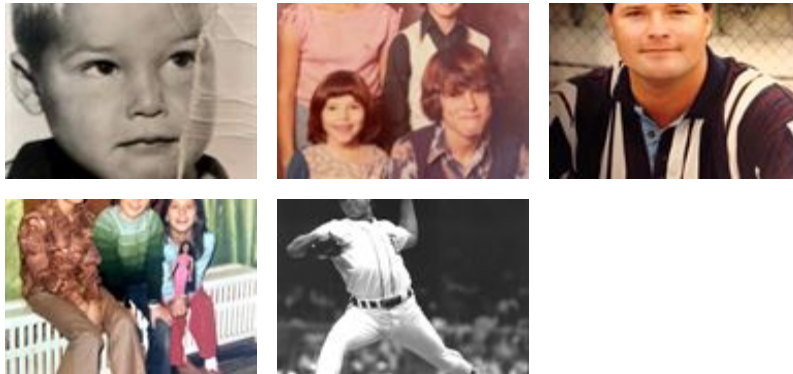
