Age 67, of Wilmington, IL passed away Monday, December 21, 2015 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee, IL. Born June 3, 1948 in Joliet, IL to the late Allen and Eleanor (nee Thontlin) Hutton.

He is veteran of the United States Army, having served during Vietnam and was awarded the bronze star. Graduate of Wilmington High School, Class of 1966.
