



Clarence "Carl" Noonan

February 4, 1951 - March 14, 2012

Age 61, of Harvielle, MO, formerly of Braceville, IL, passed away suddenly, Wednesday, March 14, 2012, at his home. He was born February 4, 1951 in Dubuque, IA. Clarence was a member of Painter's Union, Local #33 for 23 years and also owned and operated Handyman and Sons in Braceville for 20 years. He was a member of the Main Street Baptist Church in Braidwood, an AWANA Commander for 14 years and was instrumental in the church's Sunday School Bus Ministry. He loved music, singing, playing his harmonica, and telling tall tales. Clarence was a veteran of the United States Army, having served from 1968-1971 and was a member of VFW Post #5422 in Wilmington, IL. Surviving are his son and daughter-in-law, Calvin and Virginia Noonan of Braceville; two grandchildren, Tristan and Alana Noonan; father and step-mother, Charence and Iva Noonan, Sr. of Dubuque, IA; sisters, Trish and Rhonda; and brothers, Ed, Moe, Dan, Dean, Mark, and Chuck. Preceding him in death were one son, Christopher Allen Noonan; his mother, Ruth E. (nee Bowen) Noonan; and two brothers, Raymond and Robert Noonan. Funeral services were at the Main Street Baptist Church in Braidwood, IL Monday, March 19, at 1:00 p.m. with Rev. George Hendricks officiating. Geraldine Hendricks was the organist. Interment with military honors followed at the Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery in Elwood, IL.
