



Delmar Anthony Lade

September 3, 1918 - November 19, 2013

Age 95, an Essex resident recently featured in the Nov. 9th Daily Journal regarding he and his nine siblings in military service, passed away Tuesday, November 19, 2013 at Miller Healthcare Center in Kankakee, IL.

Born September 3, 1918 in Beaverville, IL to the late William and Ida (nee Ponto) Lade. Married for sixty years to Charlotte (nee Warren) Lade who expired January 14, 2005. Retired from AO Smith after thirty-six years of employment. He was an avid sports viewer and a daily patron of Ray's Ranch House in Essex. Veteran of the United States Army Air Corp having served during World War II. Member of the Essex Methodist Church. Past Master of the Masonic Lodge in Gardner, IL.

He is survived by his son, Dennis (Marsha) Lade of Kankakee; his daughter, Chardell (Alan) Smallwood of Bourbonnais; three adult grandchildren, Shawn (Chasity) Lade of Kankakee, Aaron (Amber) Lade of Grant Park, IL and Courtney Smallwood of Chicago, IL; six great-grandchildren, Riley, Preston, Adriana, Benjamin, Kendell, and Mila; brother-in-law, Frank Vining of Springfield, IL; and of his ten siblings, surviving are his sister, Nelda Garrett of Limestone, IL and brother, Joseph Lade of Bloomington, IL. Preceding him in death were eight brothers, Glenn, Stanley, Archie, Cecil, Herbert, Lloyd, Bill, and Vernon.
