December 23, 1927 - March 12, 2020

Age 92, of Braidwood, IL passed away on Thursday, March 12, 2020 at Heritage Heath in Dwight, IL. Born on December 23, 1927 in Upsala, MN to the late Axel and Ellen Bergman. She was the valedictorian of the 1945 class of Reed Custer High School, attended Joliet Junior College and graduated from Webster University in St. Louis, MO with a bachelor's degree in management. At the time of her retirement in 1986, Gloria had been a Civil Service employee for 22 years. She married Robert E. Moore in 1947 and her greatest role in life was that of mother and grandmother. Gloria loved Braidwood and was a great historian as well as a strong supporter and charter member of the Braidwood Area Historical Society.
