James Hutton

Age 72, of Braidwood, IL, passed away Sunday, May 26, 2019 at Presence St. Joseph Medical Center in Joliet, IL. Born December 2, 1946 in Joliet to the late Allen and Eleanore (nee Thontlin) Hutton. Jim Graduated from Wilmington High School, Class of 1964. Member of the International Union of Operating Engineers Local #150 in Countryside, IL for 53 years. Jim retired from Gallagher Asphalt, Joliet Plant in March 2006. Past Master of the Braidwood Masonic Lodge #704 and lifetime member of the Wilmington Masonic Lodge #208. Member of the Loyal Order of the Moose Lodge #241 in Wilmington. Jim served his community in many ways. He worked diligently for 12 years on the Braidwood Zoning Board, was Public Building and Property Commissioner, Braidwood Food Pantry Board, member of Braidwood Baseball Association, and was part of the chain gang for Reed-Custer High School Football. In his early years he operated Wilmington Lanes along side of his brothers.

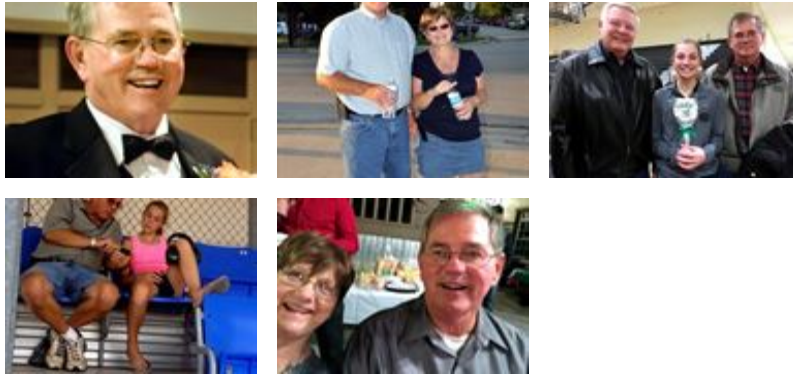
