April 3, 1916 - August 22, 2010

Jessie Berg, 94, of Braidwood, IL, passed away Sunday, August 22, 2010, at her home, with her family by her side. She was born April 3, 1916, in Torino, IL, near Braidwood, to the late John and Mary (Faletti) Viano. Jessie was a lifelong resident of Braidwood. She was a member of the Immaculate Conception Church and the Council of Catholic Women in Braidwood. Jessie was formerly employed at Grinchucks Pants Factory in Braidwood and for M.J. Donna. She retired from the position of secretary to the Will County Superintendent of Schools in Joliet, was the first secretary for the Braidwood Recreation Club and secretary for the Kansas City Royals (spring training) in Ft. Myers, FL. Jesse was part of a team of four that was first in state for short hand in 1933. Several years ago, she organized a group of women known as Santa's Helpers. They made items of clothing for the less fortunate and items such as lap afgans and walker pockets for nursing home residents and hospital patients. In her leisure, she enjoyed embroidery, knitting, crocheting, quilting, and watching baseball and stock car racing. Surviving were her daughter, JoAnne (Francis) Cavanaugh and son, Jim "Bounce" Frost both of Braidwood; grandchildren, Sheree (Chris) Earley, Frank (Kelly) Cavanaugh and Scott Cavanaugh all of Braidwood, and Jennifer (Phil) Schrieber of Aurora, IL; great-grandchildren, Brian and Courtney Earley, Frank, Kyle, Amanda, and Brandon Cavanaugh, and Kaiden and Lydia Schrieber. Preceding her in death were her husbands, Hubert "Red" Frost in 1958 and Richard Berg in 2002. Funeral services were from the R.W. Patterson Funeral
