They have run The Essex Inn for 48 years together. Sue could be found daily grilling burgers and entertaining customers. She never met a stranger and loved to play euchre and cheer for opposing local sports teams to light up local fans. If you were lucky enough, you could catch her on the dance floor doing her own hillbilly stomp.

She is survived by her devoted husband, Pat, and their two children, Mary Michele (Matthew) Cannon and their two children, Jack and Caitlin, of Naperville, Illinois, and Ward Edward (Andrea) Foley and their four children, Michael, Samantha, Christopher, and Mary, of Essex, Illinois. Also surviving siblings are Jimmy (Sue) Wagoner of Flippin, Arkansas, and Tina (David) Kisdied of Heber Springs, Arkansas.

She was preceded in death by her parents and three brothers, Shug, Leon, and Mickey.
