Age 69, of Braceville, IL passed away on Saturday, April 3, 2021 on the family farm. Mike was born on October 31, 1951 in Joliet, IL to the late Andrew “Duke” and Gladys (Johnson) Perino. Mike was raised in Braceville and graduated from Gardner-South Wilmington High School in 1970. Mike was a police officer for the Braceville Police Department and a part time road Deputy with the Grundy County Sheriff’s Department in the 70’s and early 80’s. 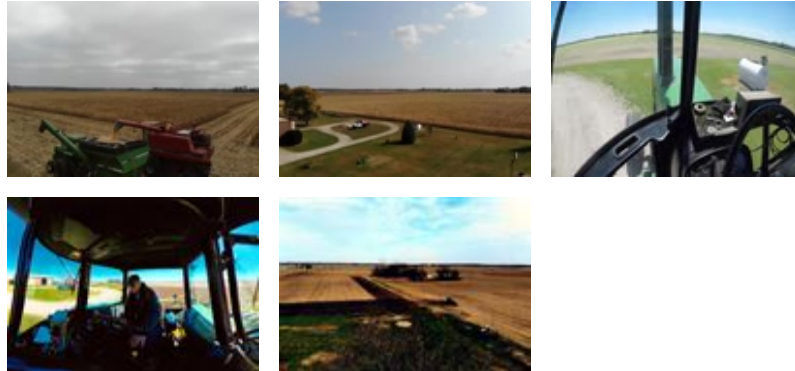
