Richard "Glen" Crater

Age 90, of Braidwood, IL, passed away Sunday, May 15, 2016 at Miller Rehabilitation in Kankakee, IL. Born August 27, 1925 to the late Frank and Erma (nee Russell) Crater. Glen, along with his wife, Marie, owned and operated Crater's Royal Blue in Braidwood for 20 years. He was a Veteran of the United States Army, having served during WWII. Glen was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Braidwood.
