Age 87, of North Fort Myers, FL, formerly of Custer Park, IL, passed away Saturday, September 20, 2014 in Florida.

Robert was born February 8, 1927 in Cabery, IL to the late Frank E. and Beulah A. (nee Quayle) Caise. Educated in Braidwood, he was a graduate of Reed Custer High School, Class of 1944. He was a WW II Veteran of the U.S. Navy, having served from 1944-1946, and later in the Reserves from 1946-1951. On March 31, 1951 he married the former Mary Alice Baber at the Presbyterian Church in Braidwood, IL. He then served aboard the USS Radford during the Korean Conflict from 1951-1953. Upon his honorable discharge, he was employed at the Joliet Arsenal and later at Johnson & Johnson in Wilmington, IL. He was a member of Laborers Union, Local #75 in Joliet, IL, having retired in 1988. Robert was an avid sports fan and enjoyed golfing and spending time with his family and beloved dog, Casey.
