Age 78, of Gardner, IL, passed away on January 5, 2022 at Advocate Good Samaritan Hospital in Downers Grove. Rodney was born on June 9, 1943 in Joliet, Illinois to the late Fred and Pearl Ford.

He graduated from Gardner-South Wilmington High School. He married Sharon Ford (Austin) on January 9, 1965 in South Wilmington, Illinois.
