



Ronald V. Maly Sr.

June 21, 1927 - November 11, 2014

Age 87, of Braidwood, IL passed away Tuesday, November 11, 2014 at Kindred Hospital in Northlake, IL. Born June 21, 1927 in Wilmington, IL to the late Charles and Mary Ann (nee Friddle) Maly.

Ronald is a veteran of the United States Army, having served in World War II and the Korean Conflict. He retired from Uniroyal Chemical after several years of employment. Member of the First Presbyterian Church in Braidwood, where he served as an elder and greeter. He was also a member of the Braidwood Lions Club, American Legion Koca Post # 39, lifelong member of the Wilmington VFW Post # 5422, and a lifelong member of the NRA. He was an avid gun collector and a diehard Chicago Cubs fan.

Surviving are his wife, Mary E. (nee Clark) Maly of Braidwood, whom he married January 30, 1960 in Wilmington; two children, Charles Maly of Braidwood and Kathleen (Dan) Atwood of Godley, IL; seven grandchildren, Crystal (Micah) Strief, Monica (Tony) Hughes, Mark Stanislaus, Amanda Atwood, ArRon Atwood, Thomas Maly, and Rebecca Maly; two great-grandchildren, Emily Hughes and Owen Strief; three brothers, Charles J. 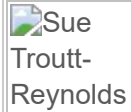
