Vincent Jay Bolatto, 74, of Essex, IL, passed away suddenly, Wednesday, September 28, 2016 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee, IL. He was born January 3, 1942 in Joliet, IL, to the late Stephen and Ellen Marie (nee Dunn) Bolatto.

Vince has served Essex Township as Road Commissioner for the past 38 years and was a lifelong farmer in the Essex and Bonfield area. He was a member and former Fire Chief of the Essex Volunteer Fire Department. He was also a former Police Chief for Essex and he served on the Board of Directors of the South Wilmington Sportsman's Club in Essex.

Surviving are his long-time girlfriend, Geneva Staehling of Essex; one brother, Steven Bolatto of Braidwood; three sisters-in-law, Alberta Bolatto of Wilmington, Judy Bolatto of Bonfield, IL, and Betty (Francis) Cavanaugh of Wilmington, IL; eleven nieces and nephews.; fourteen great nieces and great nephews; and 5 great great nieces and great great nephews.

Preceding him in death were three brothers, Eugene Bolatto, Jerome Bolatto, and Joseph Bolatto; and one sister-in-law, Mary Bolatto.

Funeral services will be at the R.W. Patterson Funeral Homes, Ltd. & Crematory, Braidwood Chapel, Tuesday, October 4, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. with Rev. Show Reddy Allam officiating.

Interment will follow in Mount Olivet Cemetery in Braidwood. The pallbearers will be fellow commissioners from several area townships.

The visitation will be Monday, October 3, 2016, from 4-8 p.m.
